CARRYING FORWARD BABASAHEB'S VISION

Rahul Gandhi has said that social justice is his life's mission and he has backed those words with action.

Guided by Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar's vision, he continues to fight for an India built on dignity, equality, and constitutional rights. Congress party and Rahul Gandhi's sustained demand for a caste census pushed the government to announce that caste will be included in the upcoming decadal census.

The Long Fight for the Caste Census

Even as the BJP–RSS opposed it, Rahul Gandhi consistently pushed for a caste census. After the government's announcement, he said the exercise must be meaningful – not symbolic – by clearly showing how marginalised communities are represented across positions of power. He also asked the government in Parliament to spell out the process and timeline, but received no clarity.

Congress Leading the Way

The Congress government in Telangana conducted a caste survey, which is now a national model for its transparency and clear purpose. Welcoming the exercise, Rahul Gandhi highlighted one key driver of social mobility: access to English education. He argued that English, alongside learning Indian languages, broadens opportunities in the workplace. He criticised the BJP for weakening English education in government schools while ensuring their own children study abroad.

Hidden within this injustice is "Not Found Suitable": a category with no clear guidelines, often used by educational universities to label candidates from marginalised communities and deny them key positions.

On Manyavar Kanshi Ram ji's birth anniversary, Rahul Gandhi addressed the Samajik Parivartan Diwas in Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh. He also wrote to the Prime Minister requesting the Bharat Ratna for Manyavar.
