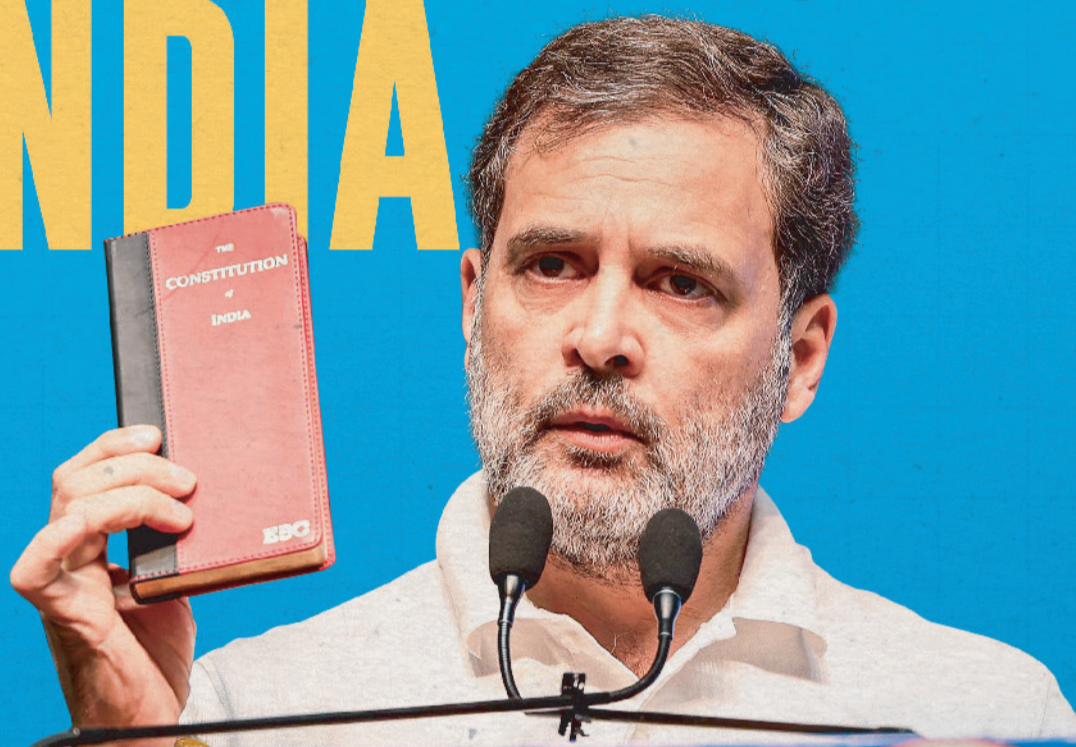

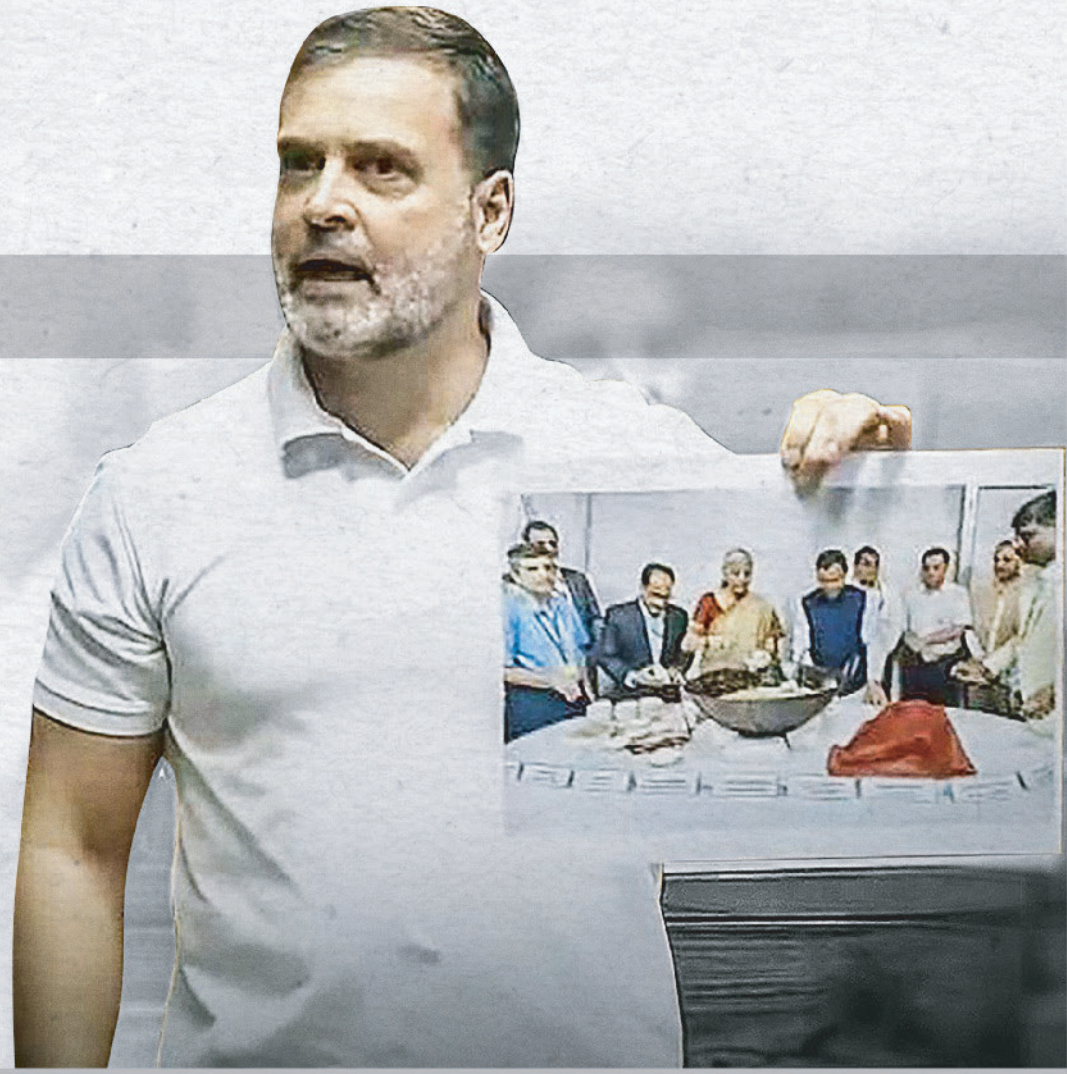

IN PARLIAMENT

73% of India's Population Remains Underrepresented

Speaking on the Union Budget, **Rahul Gandhi emphasised the stark reality that while Dalits, Adivasis, and OBCs make up 73% of India's population**, they remain significantly underrepresented in both business and governance spheres. He criticised the BJP government's failure to include officers from the Dalit community in budget consultations.



Constitution vs Manusmriti

During a parliamentary discussion commemorating 75 years of the Constitution, **Rahul Gandhi addressed the conflict between the Constitution and Manusmriti**. He explained that while the BJP opposes Babasaheb's Constitution, they follow the Manusmriti—a text that promotes caste discrimination.



Production and Participation

In his latest parliamentary speech, **Rahul Gandhi outlined his vision of "production and participation,"** which centers on a new development paradigm focused on increasing the marginalised communities' participation in India's wealth and institutions.

Vanchit Samaaj: Dasha aur Disha

Speaking with Dalit influencers, **Rahul Gandhi addressed the persistent barriers in education and corporate sectors for Dalits**. He also acknowledged the shortcomings of the Congress party in providing support for the Dalit community.



Samvidhan Samman Sammelans

Rahul Gandhi addressed nine Samvidhan Samman Sammelans throughout the year. **At the Nagpur Samvidhan Samman Sammelan, Rahul Gandhi paid tribute to Babasaheb for his contributions to the Constitution**. He advocated for implementing a comprehensive caste census and lifting the 50% reservation cap.

Exploring the history and resilience of Dalit cuisine with Mr. Shahu Patole. Rahul Gandhi and Patole ji discussed how Dalit cuisine remains overlooked and the historical practice of food-based caste discrimination. They also cooked some dishes together.



Empowering Dreams

Interacting with Dalit youth about their aspirations in Rae Bareilly, UP. Rahul Gandhi spoke about the importance of English education to expand job opportunities. He noted that while the BJP and RSS oppose English education, they send their own children to study abroad.



Standing Against Oppression

Discussing caste discrimination with a woman during the Bharat Jodo Nyay Yatra in Madhya Pradesh. Rahul Gandhi took a powerful stand against caste-based oppression by helping assert her right to wear slippers - a basic dignity still denied to Dalits in some villages.
