## HOPE FOR ASSAM

## A PUDUCHERRY RUN FROM PUDUCHERRY

He criticised the Lieutenant Governor, saying Puducherry is being run like a kingdom from Delhi instead of being governed from Puducherry. He said he wants decisions about Puducherry's future to be made in Puducherry, and pledged to ensure full statehood when the Congress alliance comes to power.

# TAMIL NADU'S PROGRESSIVE PATH



Rahul Gandhi observed how Tamil Nadu has shown India what progressive development linked with social justice can look like. He said the INDIA alliance will strengthen this model with direct support for women through ₹2,000/month, recruitment to fill government vacancies within a year, and scholarships for students. He added that as the BJP targets Tamil identity, the INDIA alliance will stand with the state to protect its culture and people.

# BENGAL'S IDENTITY UNDER ATTACK



Rahul Gandhi said the BJP attacks Bengal's language, history, and culture because it wants to force a "One Nation, One Language, One Religion" model. He criticised the TMC and Mamata Banerjee for polarising West Bengal and creating an environment that benefits the BJP. He asserted that only the Congress can defeat the BJP, and said a Congress government would focus on creating jobs and restoring West Bengal's industrial strength.

## DEFEATING THE **BJP'S** **UNJUST** DELIMITATION

Addressing Parliament, Rahul Gandhi revealed that the government's Women's Reservation Bill was not about women empowerment but a delimitation exercise to change the political map of India. He criticised the BJP for trying to weaken the rights of southern, northeastern, and smaller states. He promised that the Opposition would immediately pass a Bill that gave reservation to women on existing seats and included reservation to OBC women. The BJP's attempt to weaken federalism failed as the opposition united to defeat the Bill.
