SMASH THE PATRIARCHY



In Pune, Rahul Gandhi spoke about the barriers women face in education, employment and everyday life. He rejected the Manusmriti's view of women's identity as defined only in relation to their fathers, husbands or sons. India's women are its greatest strength; their journeys are their own, and they belong to nobody but themselves. While discussing the challenges of violence, disrespect, control and time, young women shared their own stories. He asked young women to be loud, proud, fight for their space and smash the patriarchy.

CLOSED DOORS TO JOBS IN INDIA

In Allahabad, Rahul Gandhi focused on the challenges youth face in finding employment. He said demonetisation and GST have weakened MSMEs and manufacturing; paper leaks, privatisation and fewer public-sector jobs have narrowed routes to public employment; and AI threatens the future of private-sector jobs. He contrasted this with Adani's growing wealth, the BJP's rising finances, and the RSS's influence over institutions. He urged students to change the system with love, not hatred.

EITHER CULPABLE OR INCOMPETENT

Rahul Gandhi took the students' fight for justice to Parliament, leading Opposition MPs in demanding accountability from Home Minister Amit Shah.

In his article, he wrote that Amit Shah was either culpable for the firing on students or incompetent, and must resign in either case. He also condemned the trolling of women protesters and demanded the Prime Minister's apology.

At a press conference in Indira Bhawan, he reiterated that everyone responsible must be held accountable.

Supporting Ankita Bhandari's family in their demand for justice and accountability.



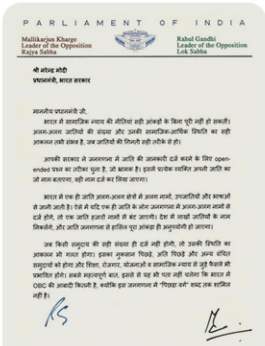
