On December 9, 2025, Rahul Gandhi spoke in Parliament on SIR and Vote Chori. He said equality is India's core fabric and accused the RSS of opposing it. **He charged the BJP with colluding with the Election Commission, citing the removal of the CJI from the EC panel, EC immunity, and deletion of CCTV footage after 45 days.** He demanded machine-readable rolls, restored CCTV safeguards, and an end to EC immunity for free and fair elections.

AIR POLLUTION IS A NATIONAL CATASTROPHE

Rahul Gandhi met Warrior Moms advocating for clean air, who described how pollution is harming their children and keeping them indoors. **He later told Parliament that air pollution has become a national crisis, with citizens in major cities breathing poisonous air and children falling sick.** He urged the government to hold a full discussion and said the opposition is ready to work together on solutions.

THE BATTLE BETWEEN TRUTH AND FALSEHOOD

Rahul Gandhi addressed the “Vote Chor, Gaddi Chhod” mega rally in Delhi, warning that vote chori is a direct attack on the Constitution. He said that the BJP-RSS is built on falsehood and driven by an obsession of holding onto power at any cost. **He asserted that the Congress stands for an ideology of truth rooted in satya and ahimsa, which will eventually remove the BJP from power.**

Interacting with carpet weavers from Bhadohi who are struggling due to US tariffs. They shared how the tariffs are straining their livelihood.



Meeting employees of Bharat Immunologicals and Biologicals Corporation Limited, India's only public vaccine manufacturer. They raised fears about privatisation and not being paid for years.



Meeting Banarasi embroidery artisans, who shared how government neglect has pushed their centuries-old craft into crisis and forced many to abandon their work.



Meeting small-scale ice cream manufacturers who struggle to compete with large corporations and do not receive adequate government support.



Meeting with the Dilli Dehat Morcha to discuss the coordinated attempt to seize village lands. They shared how land grabbing threatens their livelihoods and future.



Discussing the new Labour Codes with members of various trade unions, who flagged multiple provisions that are anti-labour.



Meeting students from the Indian Statistical Institute who shared serious concerns about attempts to undermine the autonomy of higher education institutions and impose RSS' ideology.





RAHUL GANDHI ASKS

Rahul Gandhi raised questions in Parliament about the timeline for the caste census, funds being released under the Disaster Management Fund, and privatisation of IDBI Bank. He also questioned the government on US tariffs, air quality monitoring, contractualisation in defence PSUs, and road works in Rae Bareli. While he continues to hold the government accountable and demand answers, the government has tried to evade properly answering these questions.
