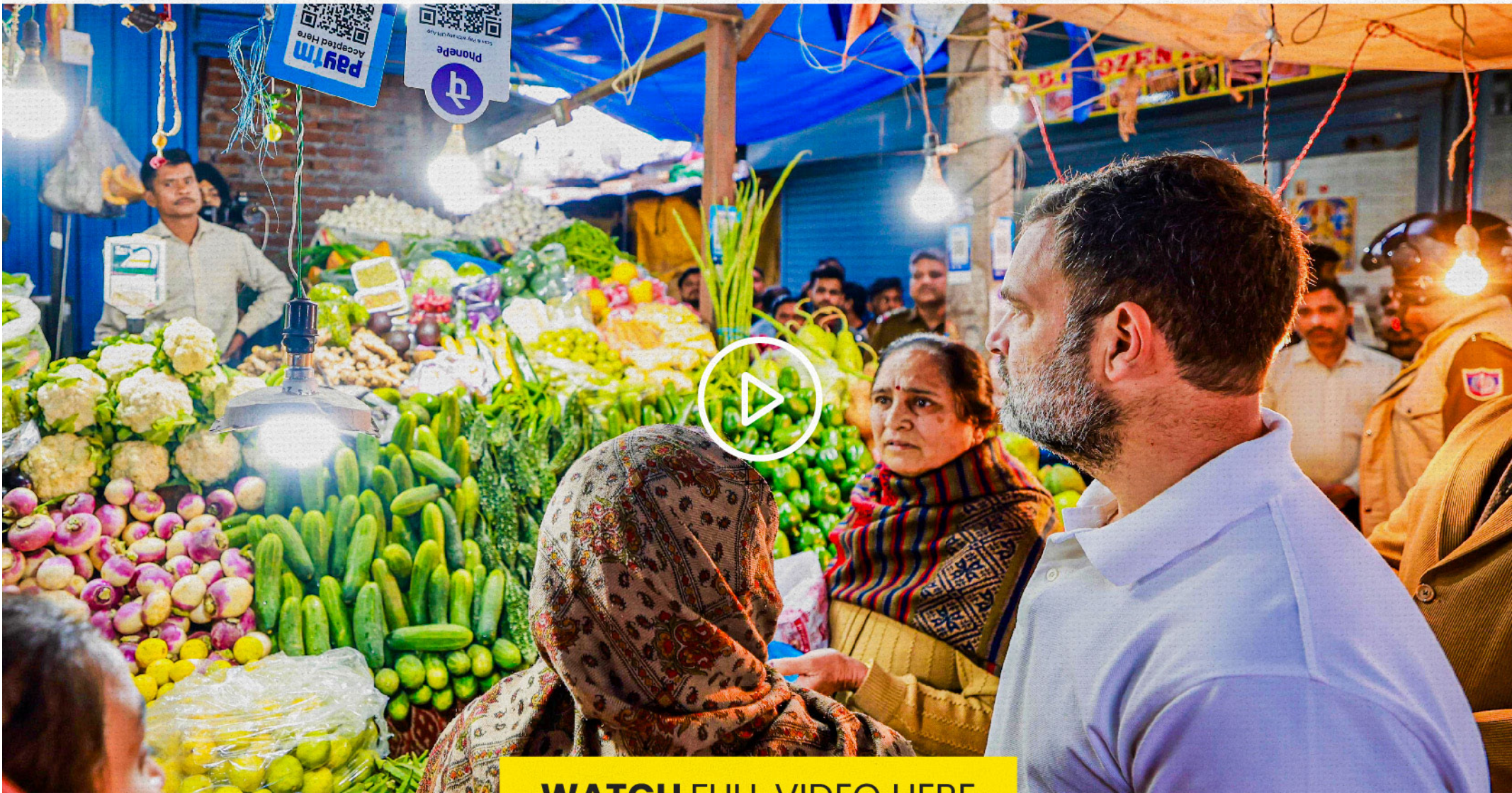
FOR DEFENDING

From January to March Rahul Gandhi led the Bharat Jodo Nyay Yatra (BJNY) – a march for justice – from Manipur to Mumbai.

This 3-month and 6,600 km long yatra focused on bringing socio-economic and political justice to the 90%. During the BJNY, Rahul Gandhi unveiled 'Paanch Nyay' – five pillars of justice for youth, women, farmers, workers, and marginalised communities – which lay the blueprint for India's future.

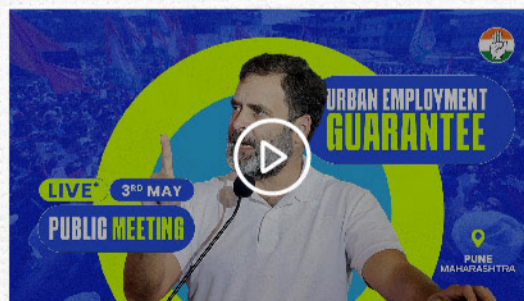

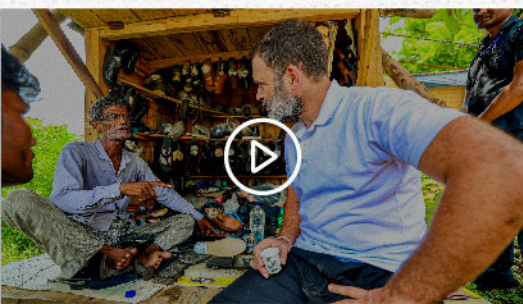


LISTENING TO THE PEOPLE OF INDIA

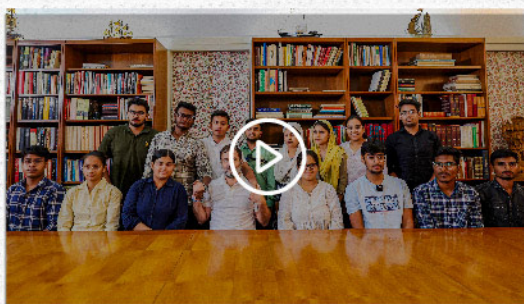
