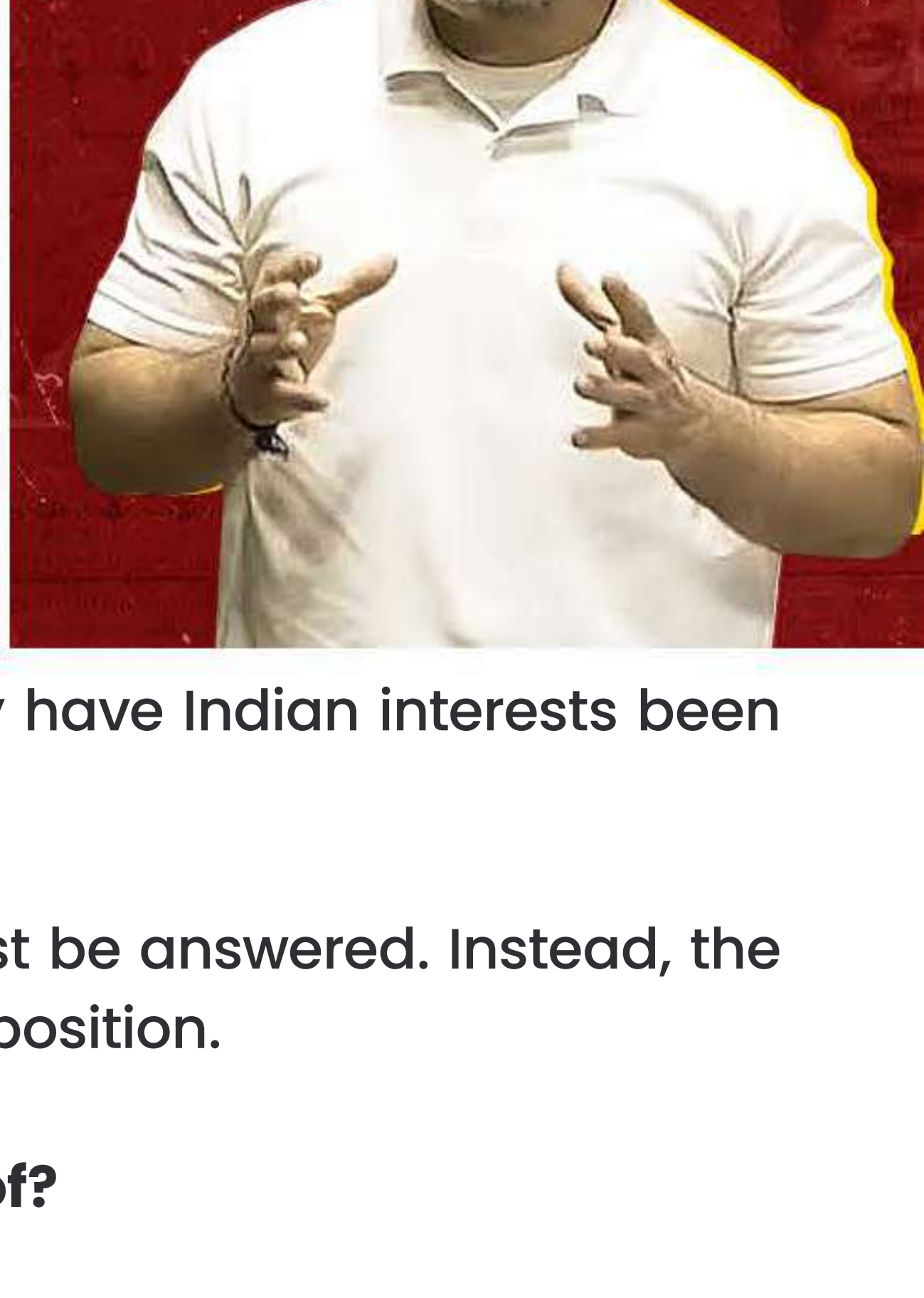


PM IS COMPROMISED

For the first time in parliamentary history, the Leader of Opposition was denied the opportunity to speak on the President's Address during the Budget Session.

Why?

INDIA'S FUTURE SOLD IN US TRADE DEAL



Rahul Gandhi said the Prime Minister had surrendered the future of 1.5 billion Indians by accepting an unfair deal. He criticised the government for handing over one of India's most valuable assets - Indians' data - to foreign interests. Rahul Gandhi also highlighted the deal's unfair impact on key sectors such as textiles, where Indian exports face an 18% tariff while competitors like Bangladesh enjoy zero-duty access. He argued that an INDIA government would have negotiated from a position of strength and secured equal treatment for India.

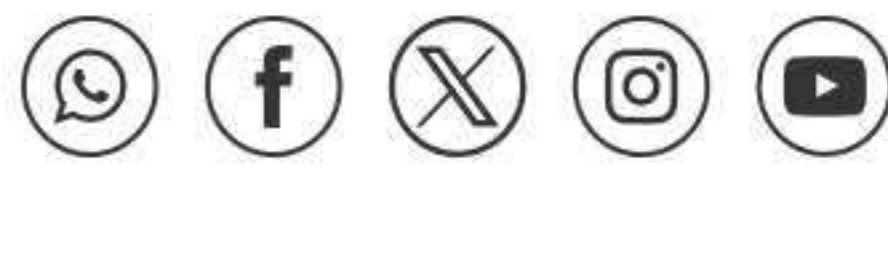

A BETRAYAL OF OUR FARMERS



Rahul Gandhi criticised the BJP for betraying Indian farmers through the US trade deal. He said farmers, already burdened by inflation, rising input costs and uncertainty over MSP, are now being pushed into unfair competition with heavily subsidised foreign crops backed by advanced machinery. Such concessions, he warned, risk undermining India's long-term agricultural sovereignty. In solidarity, Rahul Gandhi invited farmers to Parliament and pledged to continue fighting for their interests.

CHOKEHOLD ON THE BJP



Explaining why India agreed to an unfair trade deal, Rahul Gandhi noted that the Prime Minister's hands were tied. He stated that the US President knew that the PM could be cornered because the PM, Minister Hardeep Puri, and Anil Ambani's names appeared in the Epstein files - linking them all to a vile pedophile criminal. Beyond the threat of the Epstein files, Rahul Gandhi highlighted how the ongoing cases against Gautam Adani in the US also pressured PM Modi to accept the trade deal.

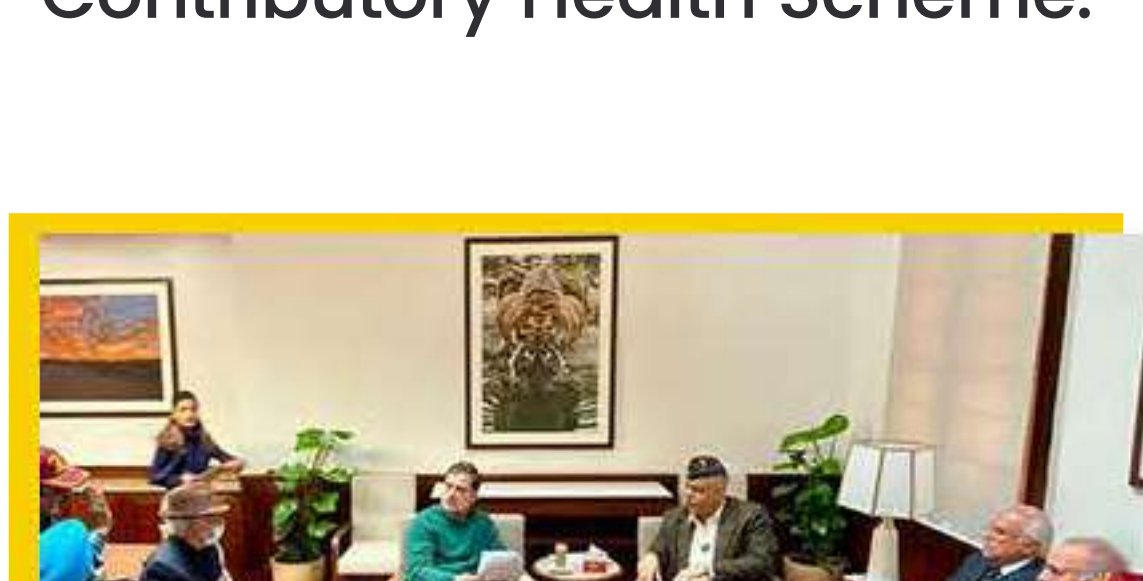
