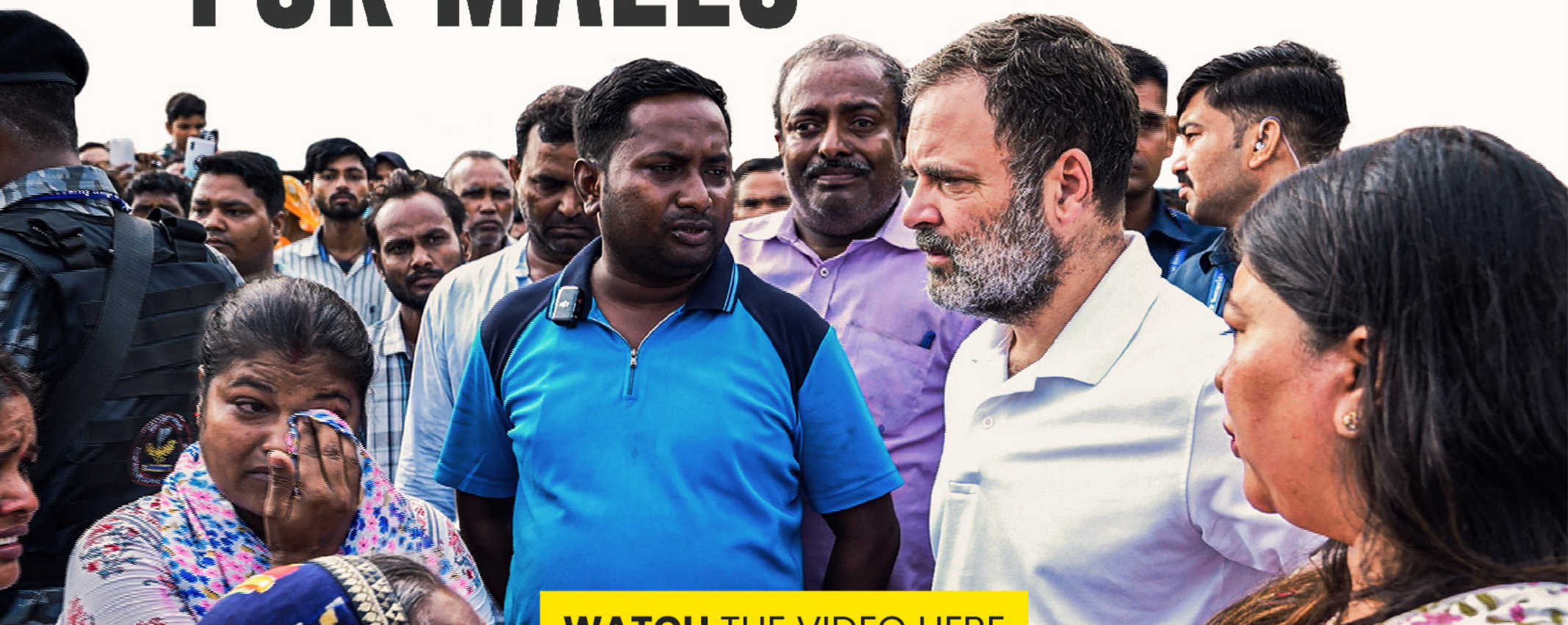

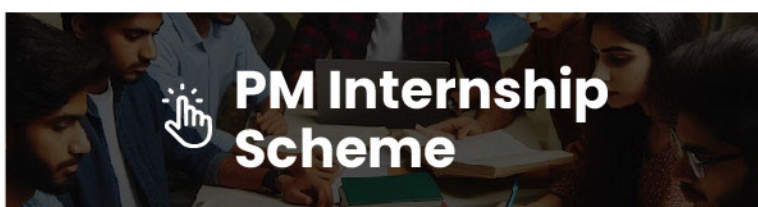

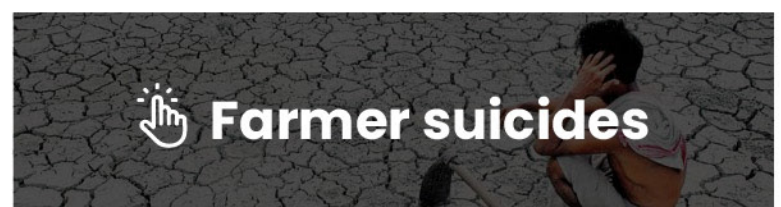
RAHUL GANDHI ASKS
