SAVE EDUCATION, SAVE THE FUTURE

Rahul Gandhi launched a nation-wide student campaign in Kota to highlight the crisis in our education system and protect the future of our youth. Stressing that the event was not political, he focused on what students are up against: limited career paths, intense competition and pressure, and a crushing financial burden. He noted that the cost of NEET coaching alone cost parents Rs 1.3 lakh crore, which rivals the Centre's entire education budget.

During the event, Rahul Gandhi also spoke to affected students and parents, and also invited young people to share their own ideas for fixing the education system.

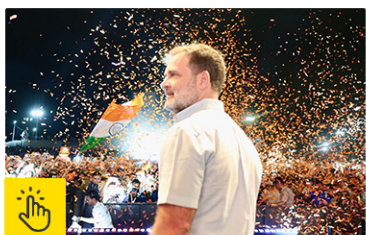

In a conversation with young women students in Keralam, Rahul Gandhi stated how women were the greatest force for change.

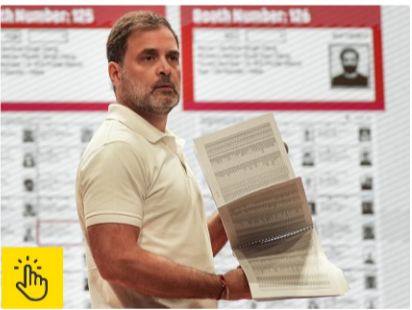


Standing with Bahujan Students

EXPOSING VOTE CHORI



Unmasking Vote Chori

Rahul Gandhi uncovered a serious electoral fraud, showing that over one lakh fake voters were added into the rolls in Mahadevapura, Bangalore Central during the 2024 Lok Sabha elections.



Revealing the Vote Chori Factory

Rahul Gandhi showcased the systematic and centralised operation of vote chori, from attempting to delete voters in Aland, Karnataka, to adding fake voters in Rajura, Maharashtra.



Presenting Operation Sarkar Chori

Rahul Gandhi showed how the Haryana election was stolen from the Congress party, proving collusion between the Election Commission and the BJP that disregarded the people's mandate.

LISTENING TO THE PEOPLE



Green over Greed

Rahul Gandhi travelled to Andaman and Nicobar to witness firsthand the concerns raised by locals over the Great Nicobar Project. He highlighted how the project is nothing but a land grab for Adani, which will destroy fragile ecosystems, ancient forests, and the livelihoods of indigenous communities.



Defeating the Unjust Delimitation

Addressing Parliament, Rahul Gandhi revealed that the government's Women's Reservation Bill was not about women's empowerment, but a delimitation exercise to redraw India's political map by weakening the rights of southern, northeastern, and smaller states.



The Poor Pay the Price

Eating lunch with auto-rickshaw drivers, Rahul Gandhi asked them how the ongoing conflict in West Asia has affected their livelihoods. They revealed how soaring fuel prices, stagnant incomes, and the absence of social security are making it increasingly difficult for their families to make ends meet.

STANDING UP FOR INDIA



PM is Compromised

Speaking to Parliament, Rahul Gandhi said the PM sacrificed India's interests to the US via the trade deal - undermining our energy security and farmers. He stated that Modi was protecting Gautam Adani from US legal action and protecting Hardeep Puri's ties with criminal Jeffrey Epstein.



Supporting India's Economy

Rahul Gandhi visited a garment factory in Haryana and warned that steep US tariffs are squeezing India's textile exports. He said the tariff shock, combined with rising global competition and weak government support, is putting factories and jobs at risk.



Sounding the Alarm on the Economy

Rahul Gandhi warned that India is heading towards an economic crisis while the government remains unprepared. He criticised PM Modi for focusing on publicity, instead of addressing hardships faced by ordinary families.
