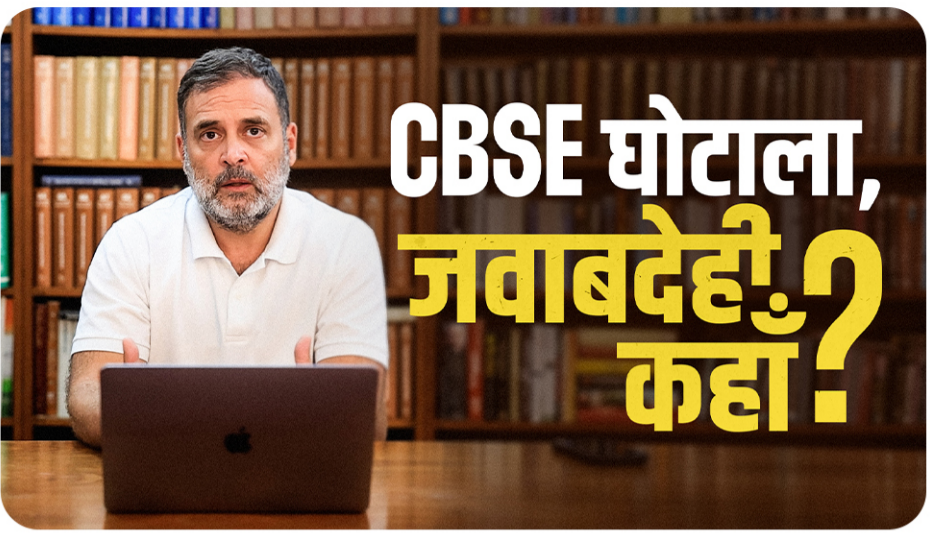
## A PAPER RIGGED AGAINST ITS OWN STUDENTS

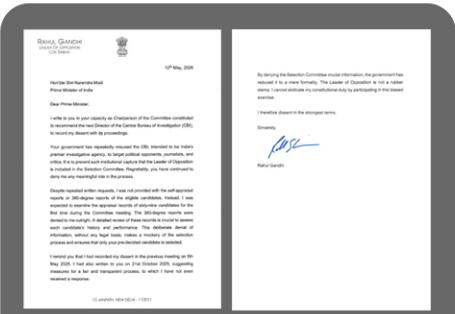
